## If you still have EEETs to submit for inclusion in your 2012 Annual EEET Summary Report ...

- The deadline to submit EEETs for this calendar year is December 14, 2012 (your EEETs must be postmarked by that date). The Program Development and Evaluation (PDE) Unit will NOT process any EEETs postmarked after that date until 2013 (This means any late EEETs will NOT be on the EEET annual summary report that will be sent out to county program faculty and staff in January 2013).
