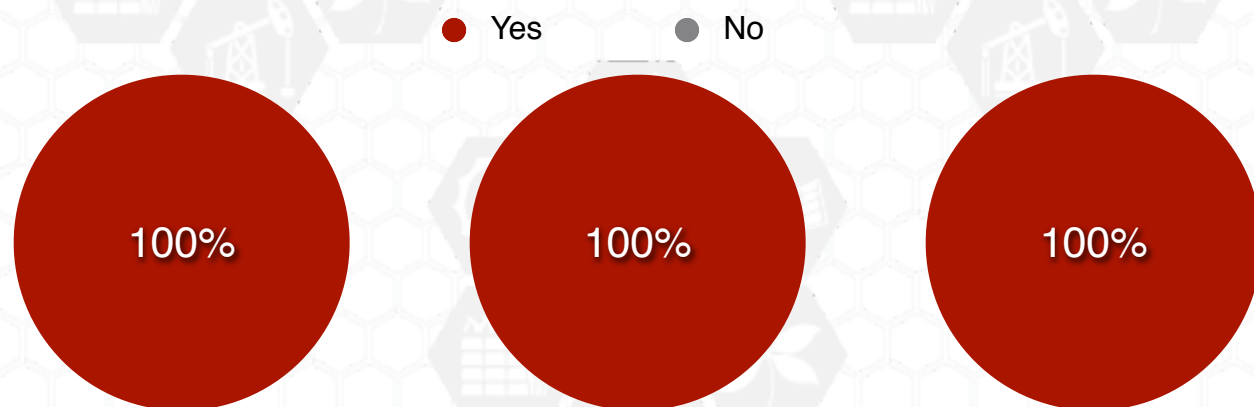


Figure 1: Do you feel today's program provided valuable information that you would recommend to others?

Figure 3: Will you use the materials and information from this program in making decisions related to renewable energy on your home, farm, or business?

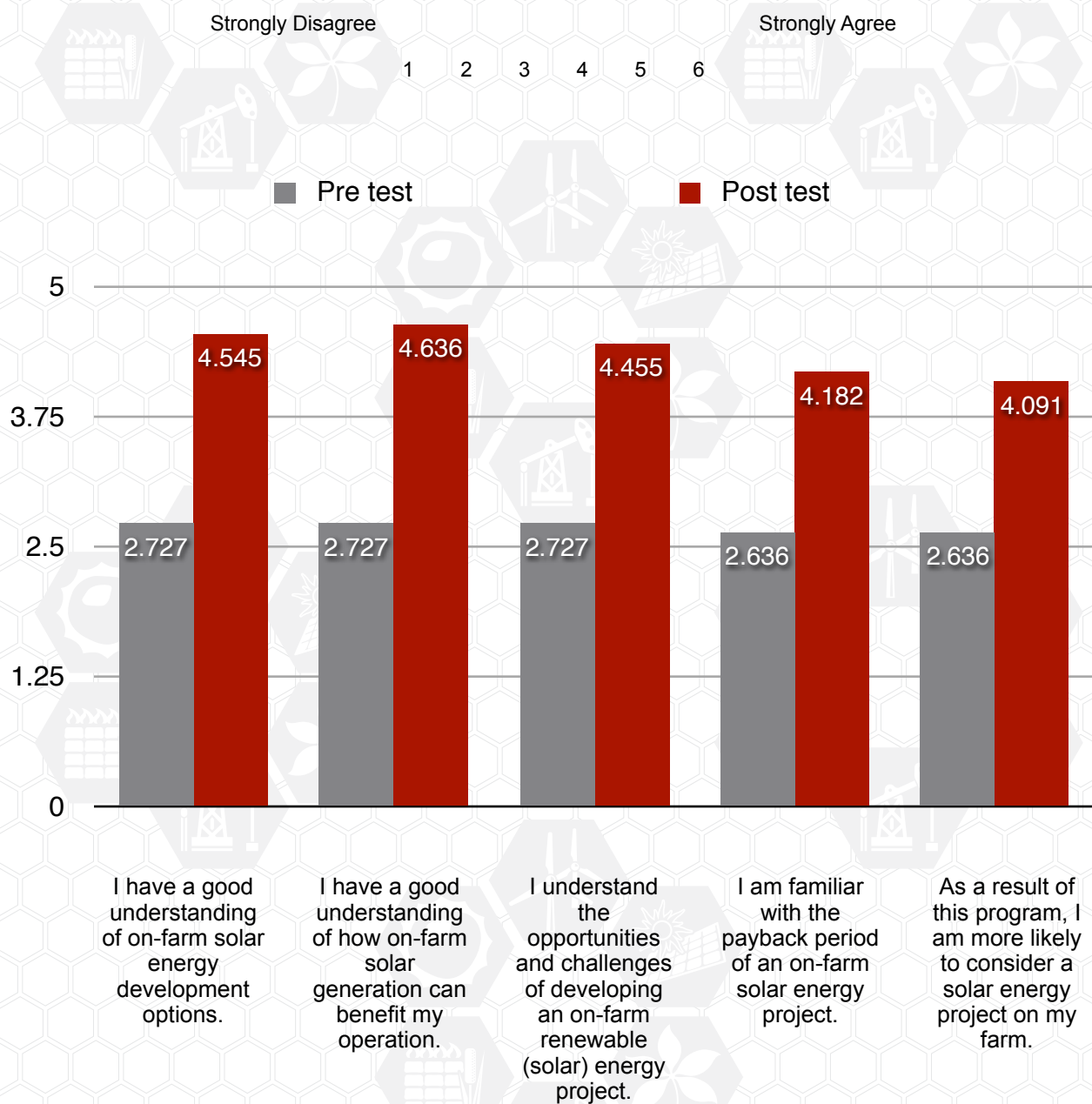
