- Responsibility was to develop plans around each of the themes (sector plans)

# Work Groups

- Trained December 2007
- Each Workgroup met at least three times from January – March
- Membership: Collaboration of involved residents, City staff, and resource providers
- Each Work Group developed an Implementation Plan with:
  - Goals, Objectives and Strategies
